Requirements

1. MA in linguistics or psychology
2. Status of a PhD student at Adam Mickiewicz University
3. Solid background in bilingualism and emotion as well as electrophysiological research
4. Experience in conducting research in bilingualism and emotion.
5. Native Polish speaker with high proficiency in English (C2)
6. Experience in presenting research findings at international conferences.
7. Publication record in peer-reviewed journals with IF (published or under review)
8. Ability to record and analyse signal electrophysiological (EEG) signal
9. Ability to perform statistical analyses (preferred environment: R) and to program experiments (preferred environment: E-prime)
10. Very good written and oral communication skills
11. Very good organizational skills, ability to work in a team, engaged in research activities.

Project tasks

1. Close cooperation with the principal investigator (PI) in the preparation of experimental stimuli (choice of stimuli, normative research).
2. Assisting in the programming of electrophysiological experiments in E-prime.
3. Cooperation in the process of recruiting participants and conducting electrophysiological experiments (pilot studies, main experiments).
4. Assisting in the analysis of recorded behavioral and electrophysiological data in MATLAB.
5. Cooperation in the process of statistical analyses and data visualization in R.
6. Participation in the dissemination of the project results (international conferences, publications, reach-out activities).
7. Carrying out other project-related tasks assigned by the PI.

Project description: Recently, research has witnessed a number of behavioral, electrodermal (skin conductance; SC), and electrophysiological (EEG) investigations of emotional language comprehension in monolingual and bilingual individuals. Little is known, however, about the physiology and brain mechanisms involved in emotional speech production, whose

understanding seems critical to advance knowledge about how emotions impact communication in social, clinical, and multicultural contexts.

This project sets out to investigate the physiology and brain dynamics of emotional speech production in the first (L1) and second (L2) language of Polish-English bilinguals. A further aim is to analyze how bilinguals prepare for emotional speech production (emotional anticipation) and its modulation by the emotional and linguistic contexts. To this end, this project combines EEG and SC to look into speech production with emotional and neutral words and sentences. Anticipation cue types (neutral cue; emotional cue) will be manipulated to examine their impact on subsequent single word and sentence production. The coordinated use of EEG and SC will provide valuable insights into the neurophysiology of emotion-speech interface in bilingualism.

This project combines interdisciplinary approaches to build new insight into the neurophysiological dynamics of emotional speech production, a critical aspect of social, political, and multicultural life. It will help to understand how emotions frame communication in today's multilingual and emotionally-charged social reality. The methodology may lead to future research on emotional speech production in clinical contexts (e.g., depression). The results of the project may have implications for education, health, and wellbeing.
