- Applications will be evaluated by a Selection Committee appointed at the request of the Project Principal Investigator. The Committee reserves the right to conduct interviews only with selected candidates. The interview is planned for December 2025. Information about the competition results will be sent to the candidates by e-mail no later than 31 December 2025. The Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science of Adam Mickiewicz University reserves the right to contact only selected candidates.
- Duration of the scholarship: 12 months,
- Monthly scholarship: PLN 1500/month,
- Planned start date: 1 January 2026.
