- Diplomas or certificates issued by colleges and universities attesting to education and degrees or titles held (in case of academic degrees obtained abroad - the documents must meet the equivalence criteria set out in Article 328 of the Act of 20 July 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 742 Polish: Dziennik Ustaw 2024 poz. 1571 t.j.);
- Information on the Applicant's research, teaching and organizational achievements;
- A research and teaching plan for the academic years 2025/2026, 2026/2027, 2027/2028;
- Consent to the processing of personal data as follows: *In accordance with Article 6 (1) (a) of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016. **The competition is open to individuals who meet the requirements specified in Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, Article 113 as amended) and who meet the following requirements:**

Candidates applying for the competition must meet the following criteria, have the following academic achievements, and submit the required documents:

- a. A PhD or habilitated doctorate in the humanities, in the discipline of history.
- b. Specialization in cultural history, with a particular focus on medieval history, including the history of religion.
- c. Leadership or membership in scientific teams at international research centers or universities (a detailed list specifying the research period, institutions, and roles performed).
- d. Membership in international academic bodies and research networks (a detailed list including the names and nature of the organizations, affiliated institutions and researchers, and key achievements of these bodies and networks).
- e. Publications in international scientific journals and publishing houses (bibliography with a breakdown of scores according to the current Polish MNiSW list).
- f. International research grants (a detailed list including the grant title, awarding institution, research period, and role in the grant).
- g. Scholarships and visiting professorships at international research institutions or universities (a detailed list).
- h. Experience in supervising young scholars (a list of supervised PhD and MA graduates along with their dissertation topics).

#### **VIII) The selection process**

1. Competition committee begins working no later than 14 days after the deadline for submission of documents.
2. Formal evaluation of submitted proposals.
3. Call to provide additional or missing documents if necessary.
4. Selection of candidates for the interview stage.
5. Interviews for candidates who meet the formal requirements.
6. The committee has the right to request external reviews of candidates' work or to ask candidates to conduct teaching assignments with an opportunity for student evaluation.
7. The chair of the competition committee announces the results and informs the candidates. This information will include justification with a reference to candidates' strengths and weaknesses. Submitted documents will be sent back to candidates.

#### **IX) Prospects for professional development**

- Conducting independent scientific research within the declared academic discipline.
- Establishing own research teams and collaborating within existing research teams.
- Proposing scientific research projects to national and international funding institutions.
- Publishing research findings in academic journals and scientific publishing houses.
