DESCRIPTION (topics, requirements, expectations):

Dean of the Faculty of Geographical and Geological Sciences at the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań announces the opening for the position of research assistant professor at the Geoinformation Department of the Institute of Geoecology and Geoinformation. The position offers a competitive salary and is funded by the research project of the National Science Center “Spatially-Explicit Uncertainty and Sensitivity Analysis for GIS Multi-Criteria Models”. All applicants who meet general requirements specified in art. 116 Act of 20 July 2018 - The Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1668, pub.) and the position specific requirements listed below will be considered.

1. PhD in geography, computer science or geoinformatics
2. Documented record of professional growth including publications in top-tier international journals and conference proceedings
3. Proven knowledge of parallel programming methods for GPU cards

Information clause for job seekers

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) No. 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC - General Regulation on data protection (Official Journal of the European Union L 119/1 of 04.05.2016) I hereby inform you that.

- 3) The purpose of the processing of your personal data is to carry out the recruitment process for the indicated position.
- 4) The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6(1)(a) of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 and the Labour Code of 26 June 1974 (Journal of Laws of 1998, N21, item 94 as amended).
