An assistant professor (research + teaching) position at the Learning and Metacognition Experimental Laboratory. The successful candidate will conduct research in line with the Laboratory's research profile (long- and short-term memory, metacognition) and teach courses in psychology and cognitive science.

- 6. Active participation in summer schools, workshops or other training related to one's research interests
- 7. Awards or commendations pertaining to one's research activities

VIII) The selection process

- 1. Competition committee begins working no later than 14 days after the deadline for submission of documents.
- 2. Formal evaluation of submitted proposals.
- 3. Call to provide additional or missing documents if necessary.
- 4. Selection of candidates for the interview stage.
- 5. Interviews with candidates who meet the formal requirements.
- 6. The chair of the competition committee announces the results and informs the candidates. This information will include justification with a reference to candidates' strengths and weaknesses. Submitted documents will be sent back to candidates.
