#### II) Job Offer description

Recruitment for a post-doc position in the OPUS project 'Historical narrative in Web 2.0 as an element of the functioning of national identities in Central and Eastern Europe' No. UMO-2020/39/B/HS3/01237.

We are looking for a motivated collaborator for a post-doc position in the Department of History at the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznan in an OPUS project funded by NCN.

The successful candidate will research digital and non-digital sources to analyse the historical narratives they contain and how they flow between the digital and non-digital worlds. In addition, the candidate will be tasked with testing software, keeping abreast of current historical policy developments and jointly preparing publications.

The research will include both quantitative methods, based on the author's prepared tools, and qualitative methods, based on traditional humanistic hermeneutics. The narratives analysed will come from Central and Eastern European countries such as Poland, Ukraine and Russia.

Detailed scope of work:

Querying and archiving, preliminary quantitative and qualitative analysis of digital sources. Analysis of metadata and historical narratives. Monitoring of current events and cultural processes in Web 2.0 such as the development of new and old channels, sites, etc. Reporting of historical narratives related to the Russian-Ukrainian war.

5. Interviews for candidates who meet the formal requirements.
6. The committee has the right to request external reviews of candidates' work or to ask candidates to conduct teaching assignments with an opportunity for student evaluation.
