I. Competition terms specified by the Selection Board:

Candidates entering the competition have to meet the requirements specified in the Act on Higher Education from 20 June 2018 (*Journal od Laws from 2021, heading 478 consolidated text*) and they must be compliant with the following criteria:

- 1) PhD in law;
- 2) excellent knowledge of constitutional law, especially the International and Regional Systems of Protection of Human Rights evidenced by scientific publications;
- 3) teaching experience in the field of constitutional law and human rights;
- 4) experience in the field of international scientific cooperation;
- 5) experience in applying and implementing research grants, financed both from domestic and foreign sources;
- 6) ability of teaching classes (lecture, seminars) in constitutional law and human rights in Polish and English languages;
- 7) proficient computer skills;
- 8) good command of foreign languages that enables lecturing and preparation of publications
