The job offer will include work in the Opus Lap grant, in an international team dealing with tardigrade research. The tasks in the project for the employed researcher will include mass cultures of tardigrades necessary for experiments, extraction of tardigrade cells, isolation of DNA and proteins, evaluation of mitochondrial functionality in conditions that modify the cytoskeleton. Participation in international conferences and publication of several scientific articles are planned, therefore the offer requires the ability to prepare manuscripts and present results at conferences.

III) Requirments and qualifications
