- completed first-cycle (Bachelor’s) studies in biology, bioinformatics, or a related field
- English language skills at least at a communicative level
- skills confirmed by completed projects:
 - application of machine learning to biological problems,
 - processing of genomic data,
 - protein-ligand molecular docking simulations,
 - acquisition and processing of data from cancer databases.
- ability to work comfortably with scientific literature and to search for scientific information
- resourcefulness and independence in laboratory work

Description of tasks

analysis of premature termination in tumor samples from patients, taking into account the effect of a potential drug.

A necessary condition for applying for the scientific scholarship is being a first- or second-year full-time Master’s student at the Faculty of Biology, Adam Mickiewicz University (AMU).

The selected candidate will receive a scientific scholarship of PLN 2825 gross, constituting an additional scholarship independent of other scholarships received from sources other than NCN projects. The scientific scholarship will be awarded for a maximum period of 4 months.

The scientific scholarship will be granted to a candidate working within the project “The role of premature transcription termination in human gene expression regulation” number UMO-2018/30/E/NZ1/00073, supervised by dr hab. Kinga Kamieniarz-Gdula, AMU prof.
