**I. Competition terms specified by the Selection Board:**

Candidates entering the competition have to meet the requirements specified in the Act on Higher Education from 20 June 2018 (*Journal of Laws from 2018, heading 2020 of Article 85*) and they must be compliant with the following criteria:  
The candidate must have:

1. a master's degree in pedagogy, taking into account specialization modules (specialties) related to early school and / or pre-school education;
2. publication achievements adequate to the degree of development of a scientific career;
3. motivation for scientific work, independence, communicativeness;
4. predisposition to didactic work;
5. knowledge of the Polish language sufficient to conduct didactic classes with students;
6. fluent use of information technology;
7. knowledge of the specificity of higher education in line with the Bologna Process,
8. proven experience in working with children in preschool and / or early school age is welcome.

**II. Documents required :**

1. The application of the candidate;
2. *Curriculum Vitae*;
3.
