#### Basic information

#### About the Project

The project's key aim is to develop and produce the first critical English-Latin edition of the "Chronicle of the Poles". The strategic objectives of the project are threefold:

1. to increase access to one of the most fundamental sources for history of the twelfth century Poland by providing English translation of the original Latin text, as well as
2. to provide English-speaking researchers with an in-depth commentary to this source material, referring to the history of the Poles and thus to contribute to the original purpose of the Chronicle, and
3. to integrate history of Poland and East Central Europe into the universal history.

#### II) Job Offer description

The post-doctoral fellow in the project *The "Chronicle of the Poles" by Bishop Vincentius of Cracow also known as Kadubek. First critical Latin-English Edition* will involve working closely with the Principal Investigator and the research team to deliver the first critical Latin-English edition of the "Chronicle of the Poles". The key aspects of the role involve but are not limited to the preparation of the definitive Latin text of the "Polish Chronicle", working on the preparation of the final edition of the definitive text. Under the supervision of the Principal Investigator, the post-doctoral fellow will be responsible for: participation in source and historiographical research to establish a framework for historical analysis; participation in the review of relevant archival sources and published research output (archival and library searches); active dissemination of research results in English (international conferences, publications in high ranking journals in Poland and globally); management of work schedule; quality control of acquired data.

#### III) Requirements and qualifications

The competition is open to individuals who meet the requirements specified in Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 and who meet the following requirements:

1. PhD in History (preferably in Medieval European History) and/or Latin or Latin philology obtained within 7 years before joining the project [This period may be extended by a time of long-term (in excess of 90 days) documented sick leaves or rehabilitation leaves granted on account of being unfit to work. In addition, the period may be extended by the number of months of a child care leave granted pursuant to the Labour Code and in the case of women, by 18 months for every child born or adopted, whichever manner of accounting for career breaks is preferable]

**Please note:** A person employed as a post-doctoral fellow must have been conferred their PhD degree by an institution other than Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań or must have completed a continuous and evidenced post-doctoral fellowship of at least 10 months in another institution than the host institution for the project and in another country than the one in which they have been conferred a PhD degree.

#### **VIII) The selection process**

1. Competition committee begins working no later than 14 days after the deadline for submission of documents.
2. Formal evaluation of submitted proposals.
3. Call to provide additional or missing documents if necessary.

4. Selection of candidates for the interview stage.
5. Interviews for candidates who meet the formal requirements.
6. The committee has the right to request external reviews of candidates' work or to ask candidates to conduct teaching assignments with an opportunity for student evaluation.
7. The chair of the competition committee announces the results and informs the candidates. This information will include justification with a reference to candidates' strengths and weaknesses. Submitted documents will be sent back to candidates.
