Recruitment concerns the project:

„*The role of ubiquitination of L1 capsid protein in the Human Papillomavirus infection*” – description of the project available at: https://projekty.ncn.gov.pl/index.php?projekt_id=591109

The aim of the project is to investigate previously unknown mechanisms regulating the HPV life cycle arising from post-translational modifications (ubiquitination) of the major capsid protein L1. The knowledge gained will enable a better understanding of the HPV replication cycle and the identification of new potential pathways to block infection. The insights gained from this research will provide a better understanding of the HPV infection cycle and potentially identify novel routes for blocking viral infection and release.

I. Scholarship Description:

- The selected candidate will become a member of the research team in the project, implementing the wet-lab experiments
- The amount of the scholarship: **1,500 PLN** per month for **12 months**
- Anticipated starting date **1.05.2026 r.**
- You will be part of a small research team of closely cooperating biologists and biotechnologists
- We will support the development of your scientific career

II. Requirements for candidates:

- **Bachelor's degree in biology or biotechnology**
- **Completed the third year of bachelor studies**
- Knowledge of molecular biology and biotechnology
- Experience in molecular biology techniques, working with DNA, RNA, and proteins will be appreciated
- Demonstrated expertise in the HPV field
- Good command of the English language, enabling the use of professional literature
- Reliability and enthusiasm for research work
- Ability to work in a team
- Self-discipline
- Striving for independence in scientific work
- The selected candidate will be required to conduct their master's thesis research at the Department of Molecular Virology.
